When & how do I pay dues?

Invoices are sent out January 1. Payment is due by January 31. Mail your payment to REPOA 111 Rivers End Drive, Seaford DE or simply put it in the black box labeled REPOA Board at the mail kiosk.

When is the annual meeting?

Typically the third Tuesday in October. Watch your email and signs at the mail kiosk for date, time, and location as it gets closer.

Run for a two-year term board position, volunteer for cleanup days, help out with social event planning, join a committee (welcome, safety, pond)
